All Holiday Heights residents will receive one (1) free 65-gallon trash, and one (1) free 65-gallon recycling can. If you wish to receive a 95-gallon can for either trash or recycling or both please call 732-349-4616.

You **<u>DO NOT</u>** need to call if you are okay with receiving the 65-gallon sizes.

This is for trash and recycling only!
It does not change the way leaves are picked up.

Once you receive your new can, please put your old can(s) out to the curb for the township to pick up.

All recycling, including cardboard boxes must fit in the recycle can, if you have excess, please call the township for a bulk pickup.

You can no longer place garbage in black bags to the curb and garbage and recycling must be separated in the appropriate cans. Please do not combine garbage with recycle.

CODE COMMITTEE

The Code Committee meets Monday mornings from 9:30AM -11:00AM in the Small Card Room (SCR) in the Office Building and are available to answer questions & provide guidance necessary for all exterior project requests. You can also call 732-244-8686 Ext.#220 and leave a message.

We continue to require approval for any exterior project before work begins.

An approved Exterior Project Application Form, including all specifications necessary for the proposed project, as well as a Holiday Heights Project Permit are required before any work can begin. Please note: A Berkeley Township permit will be required when applicable. A copy of the Berkeley Township permit, as well as the Holiday Heights Project Permit, are required to be posted prior to the start of any work.

The Code Committee continues to process applications for exterior projects as quickly as possible. The expected time for review and approval is approximately two (2) weeks. We ask for your patience and your consideration of this timeline when planning all projects.

Complaint Notices

"All complaints must be submitted in writing, including your name, address and signature, to the Code Committee.

All complaints must include photos of the violation.
Unsigned or verbal complaints or complaints from
"concerned neighbors"

will not be accepted."

"If it is important enough to complain, it should be signed."

You can obtain these forms from the Holiday Heights website or from the Association office.

RESERVING A DATE FOR EVENTS, MEETINGS OR TRIPS

To reserve a room in one of our buildings for any event, meeting or when scheduling a trip, you must first contact the office for available dates. A Calendar Appointment Form must be completed for all reservations. The Recreation Chairperson and the Liaison Director for Recreation must approve all requests.

MAIL DROP BOX – For your convenience, when the office is closed, you can drop off your association dues payments or any other documents, in our convenient mail drop box located outside the front door to the Office Building.

HOMEOWNER STATUS UPDATES:

It is very important that the office is notified of the following so we can update your master file accordingly:

- 1. Change of marital status-(deceased spouse or divorce).
- 2. New Residents that have joined your household.
- 3. Valid phone number and an emergency contact number.
- 4. Email address-(one is required per household). It only takes a minute to update your records and we encourage you to do so.

RELOCATING- If you are planning on relocating to another address, selling your home, leaving your home vacant or have any other changes regarding your Homeowner status, please notify the office so your information can be updated in our master files.

GARAGE/ESTATE SALE PERMITS

As per the Berkeley Township Municipal Code: Chapter 5-7.4: "The assessed owner of a property may have two (2) garage or yard sales per year. Each sale may not consist of more than two (2) consecutive days. A Berkeley Township permit is required to be obtained for each vard sale conducted. There is no fee for the first permit. There will be a five dollar (\$5.00) fee for the second permit. Permits are only available rom the Berkeley Township Municipal Clerk."

NO DUMPING IN THE BASINS!

DUMPSTERS / PODS – Contact the Code Committee before planning to have a dumpster or storage pod placed in your driveway. Dumpsters and pods are not allowed on any street within the Holiday Heights Community.

PARKING - Commercial vehicles are not permitted in your driveway. Parking on your lawn is also not permitted.

CONTRACTOR SIGNS

No Contractor signs are to be left on lawns following completion of work.

CURBING YOUR PET-All pets must be confined within the Owner's Lot/Living Unit except when being walked on a hand-held leash, not to exceed six feet (6') in length. Pet Owners are permitted to use the easement/patch of grass between the sidewalk and the curb. Walking pets in the street is discouraged due to safety issues for Owners and pets. Pet Owners shall keep their pets off other Owners' properties. Clubhouse Grounds and Common Properties. All Pet Owners must collect their pet's feces. Failure to pick up after your pet is a Holiday Heights fineable offense for each occurrence. There will also be an additional fine for each infraction under the Berkeley Township Ordinance (05-25-OAB-3). We expect all Pet Owners to be respectful of other Owners and in return, we expect Owners to show the same respect for Pet Owners.

August 19th - First Meet the Candidates Session - Tuesday 7 pm in the Auditorium

August 30th - Second Meet the Candidates Session - Saturday 2 pm

August 31st - Final date to request, in writing, to be a Candidate Representative

September 2nd - Last date for Nominees to correct and achieve Good Standing to be listed as a Candidate

September 9th - Election Day - Ballots returned & received in the P.O. Box by 5:00 pm

September 10th - Ballots will be publicly tallied in the Auditorium at 10:00 am and results Posted

September 11th - New Director Swearing-In Ceremony

Qualifications for Office

- A candidate for the Board shall be an Owner in Good Standing as defined in N.J.S.A.45:22A-23r.
- 2. Being an Owner in Good Standing as defined in N.J.S.A. 45:22A-23r shall be the sole criterion for an Owner to be eligible to run as a nominee, be elected to the Board, and serve as a Director of the Board
- 3. Not more than one Owner of a Lot shall run for or serve on the Board simultaneously with another Owner of the same Lot.
- 4. A Director shall not serve, pro-tem or otherwise, as a chairperson or member of either standing or "ad hoc" committee, or as an officer of any club in the Holiday Heights Community and this shall not be subject to grandfathering.

Responsibilities of Office

- 1. To read, understand, abide by, and uphold the Certificate of Incorporation, Bylaws, Declaration, and the Rules, including the Directors Code of Conduct.
- 2. To understand and agree that a Director is elected as one of seven (7) equal Directors by the Owners of the Association and that each Director has an equal voice in the affairs of the Board and the conduct of the Association
- 3. To attend a voluntary pre-orientation meeting with the Election Committee Chairperson and an Officer of the current Board to provide a full understanding of a Director's roles and responsibilities.
- 4. To aid and assist in the ongoing work of the Board and the management of the Association and to accept a fair share of the tasks deemed necessary by the Board to accomplish same.
- 5. To accept Direct Responsibility associated with facilities, staff, and duties/tasks related to Board obligations.
- 6. To accept the role of Liaison Director to one or more Association committees and the work it entails.
- 7. To understand and agree that no member of the Board shall receive compensation from the Association, except for reimbursement of legitimate expenses incurred, with the prior approval of the Board, in the performance of duties and obligations as a member of the Board.
- 8. To understand and agree that a Director may not speak for or commit the Board to any action, purchase, or position without proper authority of the other members of the Board
- 9. To agree and accept that if a purchase is made or work is authorized by a Board member without approval or ratification by a quorum of the Board, the Board is under no obligation to pay and instead the Director who authorized to commit the Association would be personally responsible and the Association shall be defended, indemnified and held harmless by the unauthorized Director for all claims arising from and relating to such unauthorized purchase or work.
- To understand and agree that a Director may take a public position on any subject but shall always identify the position as their own personal opinion and not that of the Board or the Association as a whole.
- 11. To agree and accept the responsibility of attending Board and Homeowners meetings as scheduled. Three (3) unexcused absences within a three-month period or three (3) consecutive unexcused absences may be grounds for suspension or dismissal from the Board.

GRASS CUTTING POLICY

Sprinkler heads are the Owner's responsibility

All Grass Cutting Issues must be reported to the HOA Office in writing, using the Lawn Complaint Form (forms are available at the HOA Office or on our website at (holidayheights.org). Please do not call the Lawn Contractor or a Director. A complaint form must be filled out for all complaints. If no complaint form is filled out the complaint will be voided.

Damage to property such as siding, fences, borders and sprinklers will be addressed in a timely manner. Our contractor has staff to handle these repairs. Should you have damage, please take responsible measures to prevent further damage. All complaints will be inspected by a director to determine the cause and action to be taken. Repairs made by homeowners prior to the Director's inspection and without authorization by the Board, will not be reimbursed. Please ensure the cutters have a clear path and your sprinkler heads are down on grass cutting days. Sprinkler heads damaged due to headsbeing raised during the cut cycle will not be repaired by the Lawn Contractor. If you have heads that do not retract, place red do-not cut flags around the head until you can have it repaired, also confirm all ground panels are secured.

Damage to lawns such as scalping and ruts will be considered on a <u>case-by-case</u> basis. Some will grow back without intervention. The majority of ruts are caused by the ground being over saturated due to recent rain and/or over watering by the sprinklers. The driver is most likely unaware of the saturated ground until it is too late. Ruts caused by Homeowners over watering their lawn will not be repaired by the Lawn Contractor. Please check your side and rear yards as needed to ensure the ground is not over saturated. If you find there are areas that are over saturated, please obtain red flags from the HOA Office and circle the saturated areas so the mowers know not to cut that area.

No Cut Signs are a violation and are subject to a fine if placed on your lawn.

"No Cut" flags are available in the HOA Office for those not wanting the Association to cut their grass. You will need to fill out the No Lawn Cut form and you will be given flags at the HOA Office. If you change your mind and decide you want your lawn cut, please remove the flags.

Under normal soil conditions, grass requires only ½ to 1 inch of water per week. Our soils are generally wetter due to the high-water table and type of soil; therefore, discuss this with your sprinkler contractor and ask them to adjust the frequency and run times on your sprinkler system for roughly ¾ inch per week. Also ask them to adjust your system as needed throughout the watering season. Remember the water requirements for the area between the homes may be less than the front and back, work with your neighbors to establish a watering schedule. Watering your lawn every day is not needed unless it is a new seeding.

Only Holiday Heights 2025 Pool Rules

(Our Pool Rules Supersede State Rules)

- Everyone must use personal access cards to enter the pool area including guests. No sign in is required.
- All guests must be accompanied by a Homeowner/Resident and remain with the guest while in the pool area.
- No "solo/alone" swimming. Two people must always be in or at the pool.
- Children may attend the pool between 10:00am to 12:30pm and leave the pool area by 1:00pm. A
 Homeowner/Resident must be present and supervise children. No children under the age of 3 are
 allowed in the pool.
- No children or adult diapers including "Swim diapers, Swimmates, Swimmers, pull ups" are allowed in the pool.
- Smoking or eating inside the pool area is not allowed.
- No alcohol or recreational drugs are allowed in the pool, pool area, or pavilion. Only plastic bottles
 are allowed in the pool area.
- The pool and pool area must be cleared for inclement weather and emergency situations. After 30
 minutes without any thunder or lightning, you may return to the pool area.
- No shoes, flip flops, towels, goggles, or floatation devices are to be left by the steps or ladders due to safety hazard.
- Chairs, lounges, and tables may NOT be reserved. Tables cannot be utilized by anyone or group for all day or evening. The tables are for snacking only. Please keep the tables clean for others during the day and evening.
- All equipment, chairs, lounges, tables, noodles, etc. must be returned to their original place.
- All personal items left at the pool will be discarded at the end of the season.
- Shoulder length or longer hair must be secured in a ponytail or under a swim cap.
- No running, jumping or diving into the pool. No pushing, shoving, rude, loud or profane language will
 be tolerated. If you are disruptive or refuse to follow the pool rules, you will be requested to refrain
 fromthis behavior. Refusal to refrain from this behavior will result in a Director being contacted and
 you be removed from the pool area. Refusal to be removed may result in a Code of Conduct
 violation.
- All complaints must go to a Director for a resolution or implementation.
- If you have an open sore, infection, or diarrhea, please STAY OUT OF THE POOL.
- Sunscreen should be applied 30 minutes before entering the pool to avoid clogging the pool drains.
- This is a Senior Community, and we would like to keep it peaceful. Respect others.
- The pool will open on Memorial Day weekend and close on September 30th-weather permitting. Pool Hours are 8am to 8pm unless otherwise posted.

HOLIDAY HEIGHTS FIRST AID SQUAD

The Holiday Heights First Aid Squad was formed in 1987 to serve the residents of Holiday Heights. We currently work a 12-hour shift from 7 am until 1900 (7 pm). The days we work are Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday.

Each crew consists of an EMT or Certified Assessor, a driver/ lifter and an information specialist. Both of our ambulances are equipped with hydraulic stretchers that lift the patient into the ambulance.

There are 3 requirements to become a squad member: having a valid driver's license, getting CPR certified, and being able to get on and off the ambulance unassisted.

All crew members are certified in CPR and the use of an AED. Classes are provided in the squad

building, and all costs are covered by the squad. Members that want to be certified as an Assessor or EMT may take the required class at no cost. Drivers attend a CIVO or Advance Emergency Drivers class. Additionally, there are other classes offered by the town or County, and attendance is voluntary.

Uniform shirts and jackets are provided by the Squad. You will need black pants and black shoes.

Most Crews work two or three days per month, and we also have one mandatory meeting per month, usually the fourth Wednesday of the month.


